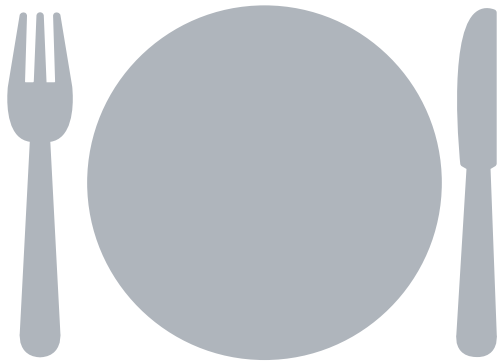


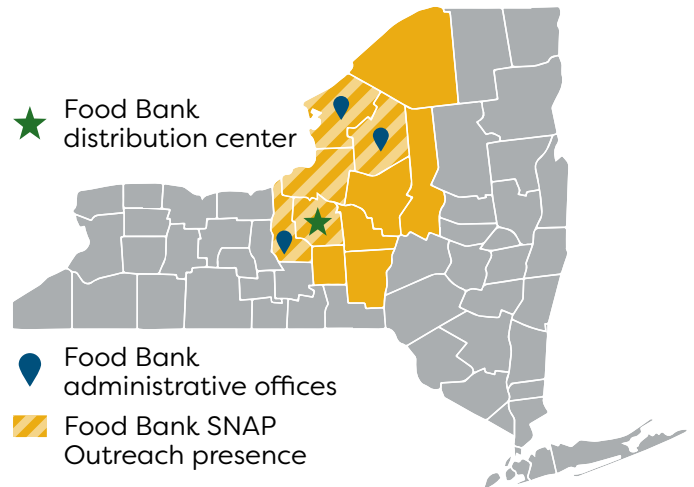
# 11 COUNTIES. 1 GOAL. END HUNGER.



Statistics reflect July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024



**22,264,010 total pounds of food** distributed, enough to provide **18,553,341 meals**



Our service area encompasses **12,334 square miles**



**5,171,748 pounds of food rescued** from **125 retail partners**



**4,940,730 pounds of produce** distributed



**2,384,680 pounds of dairy products** distributed



**316,585 pounds of hygiene & household items** distributed



Food distributed to **371 community partners**



An estimated **178,190 people** are food insecure in our service area



Every **\$1.00 donated** helps provide enough food for **three meals**



**1,064 volunteers** donated **8,310 hours** of their time



Food stored in our **108,000 square foot** distribution center



Our fleet of **15 vehicles** and **2 pact trailers** travelled **327,209 miles**

## COMMUNITY DISTRIBUTIONS



### FRESH FOODS

**21 sites** across **9 counties**

Distributed **1,832,765 pounds** of produce plus bread and assorted fresh food items



### MOBILE FOOD PANTRY

**28 sites** across **8 counties**

Distributed **850,972 pounds** of produce plus bread and assorted fresh food items at **220 total distributions**

## JUST SAY YES TO FRUITS & VEGETABLES (JSY)



### NUTRITION EDUCATION & WORKSHOPS

**149 in-person workshops** presenting nutrition topics to **1,810 total participants**

**10 counties** hosted workshops



### JSY AT THE FARMERS MARKET

**34 workshops** held over **11 weeks** with **536 total participants**

## NUTRITION INITIATIVES



### CHILD NUTRITION

**45,663 hot evening meals** distributed through Kids Cafe at **13 sites**

**25,505 meals** distributed through Summer Food Service Program at **14 sites** across **2 counties**



### SENIOR NUTRITION

**45 sites** across **10 counties**

An estimated **2,000 seniors** served

Distributed **47,913 boxes** of nutritious food, weighing **752,606 pounds**

## ECONOMIC IMPACT



### NOURISH NEW YORK

**2,998,666 pounds** of product purchased from **32 local growers & producers** and distributed to the community

Nourish New York provides funding to the Food Bank to purchase New York grown products from growers and producers to help connect local agriculture to neighbors in need.



### CNY HEALTH BUCKS

**\$17,994** distributed

CNY Health Bucks cultivates nourished communities by incentivizing SNAP usage at farmers' markets enabling low-income households to purchase additional fresh, local produce.



### SNAP OUTREACH

**8,194,604 SNAP meals** attributed to Food Bank outreach

**4,066 SNAP applications** submitted for households in **Cayuga, Jefferson, Lewis, Onondaga, and Oswego Counties**

**98%** approval rating
